October 27, 2008 - Minutes of the Indianapolis Coin Club Meeting.

Open - The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Mark Eberhardt. 28 people signed the attendance book. We met at the Northside Knights of Columbus Hall, 2100 E. 71st Street.

Visitors – There were no visitors.

The **Treasurer's report** and the **Secretary's report** were read and accepted.

Old Business – Mark reminded the members that the ISNA Show would be on Friday, October 31 and Saturday, November 1. The Secretary reported that fliers advertising the show were on the front table, and encouraged the members to take one. Mark again appealed to the members for items to put in the goodie bags for the Show.

New Business – Mark reminded the members that the Club's election of officers will be at the November meeting, and asked for volunteers for the Board and any other office that a member wanted to run for. Secretary, Vinton Dove, read the names of those who were on the slate at that point in time.

The Educational Program – The program for the night was presented by President, Mark Eberhardt, and was a continuation of the "State of the Hobby" program presented by Coz Raimondi at the September meeting. The price of Gold had fallen to \$736 per ounce and Silver and other precious metals were also lower. The difficulty in the market now is that there is no metal available to purchase. Coz had pointed out that fact in September, but it is painfully obvious to everyone trying to buy at this point in time. There was a large discussion about the prices and coins available, and Mark summarized by saying "buy the best, rarest coin you can find and afford."

The **50/50 Drawing** was run by Karl Kreck, and Dave Daniel won the prize.

Banquet – After a poll was taken among the members, December 14 was decided on as the date desired for the Club banquet, and Mark said he would check with the K of C. The exact date will be decided and reported at the November meeting.

Auction – After the break, Mark ran the Club Auction. Bob Bettcher, Karl Kreck and Vinton Dove assisted.

The club adjourned at 8:55 PM.
