August 22, 2011 - Minutes of the Indianapolis Coin Club Meeting.

Open – The meeting was called to order at 7:12 PM by the Club President, Jim Roehrdanz. (We normally start at 7:00, but Jim said his watch was running slow.) 28 of the 33 people present signed the attendance book. We met at the Northside Knights of Columbus Hall, 2100 East 71st Street.

Visitors – The President welcomed the visitors, Dave Colford, the President of the Logansport Club; Gary Connor, his fiancé, Debbie, his son, Nicholas and his daughter, Taylor.

The **Secretary's report** was read and accepted.

Old Business – None.

New Business – Joe Boling presented the Club with a 25 year membership certificate from the ANA. This started a discussion about the ANA and its Money Show, held August 13 – 17 in Rosemont, (a Chicago suburb) Illinois. Members who attended included Bill Schutt, Joe Boling, Wendell Wolka, Jim Warden, Vinton Dove and Dave Reid. It was reported that Dave Reid won \$16.00 in a “grab for the Cash” game, where his name was drawn to stand in a tent full of dollar bills which were blowing in the air. He was given 30 seconds to grab all the bills he could.

The **Treasurer's report** was read and accepted.

The Educational Program – Vinton Dove gave the program, titled “Lincoln Cents, revisited.” He discussed his latest purchases at the ANA, which included the 1916 and 1911 Matte Proof Cents. He displayed a “complete” set of Lincolns from 1909 to 1999 in blue Capital Plastic albums, and included every proof made from 1909 to 1991 except the 1909 VDB Matte Proof. He was missing some of the proofs in the 1990's because, in his words, he only pays attention to coins after 1959 once every five or ten years. His focus is on the older coins. He also had several of the error coins, such as the 1944 D/S and the 1972 and 1995 Double Dies.

After the **Break**, the **50/50 Drawing** was run by Don King, Club Treasurer.

Auction – Joe Boling ran the auction. There were 12 paid auction sheets and one donated lot from Joe Boling. Bob Bettcher, Jim Roehrdanz, Donn Wray and Vinton Dove assisted.

The club **Adjourned** at 8:39 PM.


